11 TOPICS EDUCATORS MAY NOT REALIZE ARE CONFIDENTIAL

These topics are confidential. Unless you have specific consent, you can usually share these things *only* in a professional capacity, in a private setting, and only with colleagues who need to know the information to do their job supporting the student:

- 1. Student academic records and information
- 2. Student health and medical information, including information about classification
- 3. Student disciplinary records and information
- 4. A student's family status
- 5. Other student records
- 6. Questions, answers, scores, and other information about standardized tests
- 7. Any type of teacher performance evaluation
- 8. Certain personally identifying information for students, parents, or colleagues (Some directory information can be released unless the parent has a letter on file requesting the information remain confidential. Refer to FERPA for guidelines.)
- 9. Information about the income and socio-economic status of students and their families
- 10. Co-worker personnel records
- 11. Information deemed confidential in a contract (often regarding research, standardized testing, or the settlement of litigation)
