## QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

When you stop and reflect, here are some questions to consider in this kind of situation:

- 1. What could go wrong when you meet a student after school, alone in a classroom?
- 2. Are there other appropriate places, times, or ways, to provide assistance to a student, that pose fewer risks?
- 3. Is there a school or school system policy that governs interactions with students outside regular school hours?
- 4. If there is no formal policy, what guidelines should you establish for giving assistance to your students outside regular school hours?
- 5. Does your approach allow for the same level of assistance to all your students (if they choose to accept it)?
